

Valid Identification

- ◆ **The applicant must produce two (2) pieces of identification that confirm; name, date of birth, and address.**
- ◆ **One piece of identification must include a photo.**

The following is a list of pieces of items that are considered acceptable forms of identification.

Photo Identification (Identification that provides photo, name and date of birth)

- ◆ **Driver's Licence**
- ◆ **Government Employment Card**
- ◆ **Military Employment Card**
- ◆ **Age of Majority Card**
- ◆ **Canadian Citizenship Card**
- ◆ **Indian Status Card**
- ◆ **International Student Card**
- ◆ **Passport**
- ◆ **Permanent Resident Card**
- ◆ **Possession and Acquisition Licence (PAL)**
- ◆ **Canadian National Institute for the Blind Card (CNIB)**
- ◆ **Health Card**

Non- Photo Identification (Identification that provides both the name and date of birth)

- ◆ **Birth Certificate**
- ◆ **Baptismal Certificate**
- ◆ **Hunting Licence**
- ◆ **Fishing Licence**
- ◆ **Outdoors Card**
- ◆ **Hospital Card**
- ◆ **Canadian Blood Donor Card (only if date of birth indicated)**
- ◆ **Immigration Papers**
